

LA VIE COVID-19 POLICY

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization, COVID-19 is extremely contagious. The state of medical knowledge is evolving, but the virus is believed to spread from person-to-person contact and/or by contact with contaminated surfaces and objects, and even possibly in the air. People reportedly can be infected and show no symptoms and therefore spread the disease. The exact methods of spread and contraction are unknown, and there is no known treatment, cure, or vaccines for COVID-19 at this time.

La Vie Dance & Culture cannot prevent you [or your child(ren)] from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while using La Vie Dance & Culture services or premises. Therefore, if you chose to utilize La Vie services or enter our premises you may be exposing yourself to and / or increasing your risk of spreading COVID-19

La Vie is doing its utmost to keep our clients, members, and guests as safe as possible in these uncertain times. Therefore, here is what you need to know about our protocol:

- **Reservations:** We encourage reservations at least 30-minutes prior to class to attend. Teachers cannot guarantee or accept walk-ins if a class is at capacity. You will be put on the wait list if the class is full.
- **Face Masks:** Everyone must wear a mask while entering and exiting the studio. You may choose to remove your mask in class when you can maintain 6-foot social distancing with those around you. If you do not have a mask, we will have them available for sale at the studio.
- **Reduced Class Size:** Our studio will reduce class sizes to encourage maintaining physical distance between students. The floors are marked with an X at 6 ft intervals to encourage proper spacing. Maximum capacities are: Studio 2 upstairs 30 people; Studio 1 downstairs 15 people. This will change as needed when state / local guidelines are amended.
- **Staff Safety:** All teachers will conduct a temperature check and register of attendees prior to studio entrance. Touch-less thermometer for temperature checks will be provided by the studio.
- **Waiting Areas:** Attendees will wait for all classes outside of the studio. Chairs have been removed from the welcome area to discourage congregation. We look forward to the time when we are able to linger and chat, but the entrance areas are high traffic and will be closed for now.
- **Good Health Responsibility:** All attendees need to sign our waiver acknowledging participation is welcomed as long as you are healthy and observe our new studio policies and physical distancing protocols. We will be recording names, emails and temperatures at class check in to maintain a record of wellness checks and to provide a contact list should anyone fall ill.
- **Hands-on Adjustments/Guidance:** As much as we love adjustments, our teachers will refrain from doing any hands-on work until it is in accordance with state and county guidelines. Verbal cues and demonstrations will be provided.
- **Studio & Equipment Sanitization:** To ensure your safety, we will be posting La Vie official guidelines at all entrances and in our new waivers. We have multiple sanitizing stations, non-contact thermometers, and have installed a UV Germicidal lighting system throughout the studio (for passive anti-viral effect when the studio is unoccupied). We encourage keeping doors and windows open and using fans for outside air exchange.
- **Personal Items:** Please keep your personal belongings to a minimum and remember to remove all your personal property WITH YOU. We will not be responsible for lost and found items.
- **Live Streaming:** Instagram and Facebook LIVE streaming will continue. Please contact teachers for further information.
